Pasuk 5:

וַיּוֹצֵא אֹתוֹ הַחוּצָה וַיֹּאמֶר הַבֶּט נָא הַשָּׁמִיְמָה וּסְפֹּר הַכְּוֹכָבִים אָם תּוּכַל לִסְפּּר אֹתָם ויַּאמֶר לֹוֹ כֹּה יִהְיֶה זַרְעֶךְ:

[Then in the vision, God] took him outside and said, "Look toward heaven and count the stars, if you are able to count them"—continuing, "So will your children be."

Pasuk 6:

וָהֶאמָן בַּה' וַיַּחְשְׁבֶה לּוֹ צְדָקָה:

And he put his trust in God, who thought good of him.

Pasuk 7:

: אָבֶּי הַזֹּאַת לְרָשְׁתָּה: בָּשְׂדִּים לֶתת לְךָ אֶת הָאָבֶץ הַזֹּאַת לְרִשְׁתָּה: Then [God] said to him, "I am God who brought you out from Ohr Kasdim to give this land to you to inherit it."

Pasuk 8:

וַיֹּאמַר ה' אלוקים בַּמָּה אֱדַע כִּי אְירָשֶׁנָּה:

And he said, "God, how shall I know that I will inherit it?"
